IFFCA Show Rules

- 1. Birds will be received at show venue on Friday evening 5-9 p.m. or Saturday morning 7-9 a.m.
- 2. All birds will be benched ahead of judging which begins Saturday 10 a.m.
- 3. Entries may be checked out following presentation of awards, approximately 3 p.m.
- 4. Entry fee is \$3 per bird.
- 5. All birds properly entered are under the care of the show management. Exhibits are not to be handled except by instruction from show manager. No drinkers or birds are to be removed from cages, except by Chief Steward.
- 6. Chief Steward may reclassify entries, as needed. The judge may also reclassify an entry, if he/she deems it necessary.
- 7. English language is to be used for all communications during the judging, either by the judge or an interpreter.
- 8. Decisions by judge are final.
- 9. All entries must have been bred by exhibitor.
- 10. Birds banded with a recognized, traceable current year closed band will be entered in Young (un-flighted) classes.
- 11. Over-year, un-banded birds, or birds with open, unrecognized or non-traceable bands will be entered in the Old (open) classes.
- 12. The position of the mini drinker is on the back side, placed to the left of center, five spaces from the corner of the cage.
- 13. There should be five bars between the perches. The angled cut of the perches should face up.
- 14. The show tag is tied to the first bar from the front left corner.
- 15. The show cage should have seed mix of 50% canola/rape 50% canary seed on the floor of the cage, to a depth of one half inch.
- 16. Cages are meant to be anonymous so all attempts at individualization are banned.
- 17. All efforts will be to insure all birds are properly and safely cared for during the show, but the IFFCA and SEMCC clubs will not be held responsible for any accident, mistake, loss, theft or damage that may occur to any exhibit.

50/50 seed will be available at the show venue!

IFFCA Color Descriptions

SECTION 1 - CLEAR OR TICKED

A **CLEAR** bird is one which has no dark feathers.

A TICKED bird shall have one mark on head or body to be covered by a dime and wing or tail not to exceed three dark feathers side by side to form a solid mark.

SECTION 2 - LIGHTLY VARIEGATED

A LIGHTLY VARIEGATED bird must be less than 25% dark.

SECTION 3 - MEDIUM VARIEGATED

A MEDIUM VARIEGATED bird must be 25% to 50% dark.

SECTION 4 - HEAVY VARIEGATED

A **HEAVY VARIEGATED** bird must be greater than 50% dark.

SECTION 5 - SELF OR FOUL

A SELF bird must be all dark.

A FOUL bird is one which has not more than one light mark coverable by a dime or three light feathers side by side on wing or tail.



STANDARD and Scale of Points

HEAD and NECK:

Small, round and neat, beak fine; eyes central to roundness of head and body. Neck rather fine in keeping with the head and flowing smoothly into the body lines, and of sufficient length to give a free, jaunty look to head and carriage.

10 pts

BODY:

Well filled and nicely rounded; running in a smooth downward curve from the gentle, smooth rise over the shoulders to the point of the tail. The chest also nicely rounded, but not heavy; the line of the curve to the root of the tail always being downwards. Viewed from above and behind, the body outline should be symmetrical and smooth.

10 pts

WINGS:

Compact and carried close to the body; meeting at the tips just below the root of the tail.

10 pts

LEGS:

Of medium length, showing a little thigh.

5 pts

PLUMAGE:

Close, firm; fine in quality.

10 pts

TAIL:

Close packed and narrow; being nicely rounded and filled in at the root.

5 pts

POSITION and CARRIAGE:

Semi-erect, standing at an angle of 60 degrees. Gay, jaunty; with full pose of head.

10 pts

COLOR:

Rich, soft and pure; as level in tint as possible throughout, but extreme depth and hardness as color feeding gives, are debarred.

10 pts

HEALTH:

Condition and cleanliness shall have due weight.

5 pts

SIZE:

Not to exceed 4 ¼ inches.

25 pts

TOTAL: 100 pts
